Mr. Issac Eldridge Massey, age 87 of Grant, Alabama passed away Saturday, October 12, 2019.

Issac was born on January 4, 1932 to Allan Lee & Bessie Pearl Oliver Massey on Lookout Mountain. After graduating from Fort Payne High School, he proudly served during the Korean War in the 151st Engineer Combat Battalion, later retiring from the United States Army National Guard with 23 years of service. He joined the police force in Fort Payne before moving to Guntersville, where he served as Chief Deputy for Sheriff L.P. Dickson. He went on to work with First National Bank of Guntersville and then in automobile sales until he retired in 1996. Issac enjoyed gardening and traveling and especially enjoyed reading western novels and watching old western tv programs. A member of the VFW, he was a recent recipient of the Ambassador for Peace Medal presented to Korean War Veterans.

A graveside service with full military honors will be held at 12 noon Saturday, October 19, 2019 at Walker Cemetery located in the Hebron community of Marshall County.

Mr. Massey is survived by his wife of 46 years, Martha Nell Davis Massey; a son, Phillip Wayne Massey; a daughter, Lisa Clay Pate and her husband John; two grandsons, Tony Pate and his wife Mary, and Jack Pate and his
