Mrs. Lillis Wheeler Irwin, passed away from this life after a long fought battle with Alzheimer's at Diversicare of Arab, AL.

Lillis was born July 31, 1935 in Pisgah, AL to Emmett and Nettie Wheeler. She grew up in Pisgah, before moving to Florence to attend the University of North Alabama, where she received her Bachelor's of Science in Education and also her Master's of Science in Education.

She then located to campus housing, at Kate Duncan Smith DAR School, as a young, single, independent career woman to begin her teaching profession. It was during this time, that a handsome, young cookware salesman, Mr. Jack Irwin, made a fateful knock on the door. Jack and Lillis were married in 1958. After several moves around the area, as a young couple, they decided to move back to Grant, AL where they raised their three daughters : Cynthia, Candace and Nancy.

Lillis was a lifelong educator including 31 years as Science and Physical Education teacher at Claysville Jr. High. Where memories of bug, leaf and rock collections, watercress sandwiches and SQUARE DANCING, were lovingly made along with an "occasional" stern look or paddling here or there.

She was also a very active member of First Baptist Church at Grant. Where she served in the many capacities but most notably Sunday School teacher

for 50+ years. Lastly, as the leader of her beloved Lydia Sunday School class.

As not only a teacher but an active learner, she helped to establish and bring Grant Public Library to existence so that all would have the opportunity to read and learn. Her house was a discovery cove of unique flowers and special made walking trails in nature, where she immersed grandkids and all visitors in everything Science and physical activity. Any opportunity lent itself to a hands on learning experience. She participated in dulcimer, line dancing and also took up painting during her retirement years; while taking on role as full-time caregiver to husband, Jack.

Lillis is survived by daughters Cynthia Maples (Woody) of Grant, Candace Irwin of Huntsville, and Nancy Garner (Buddy) of Grant, brother Joe Wheeler (Ila Faye) of Rosalie. Grandchildren, Brandy Maples Hudson (Larry), Shane Maples (Rachel), Taylor Garner and Joshua Garner, and Great-grandchildren Hunter Maples and Grant Maples. Along with a host of nieces and nephews, former students, and Lydia Sunday school members.

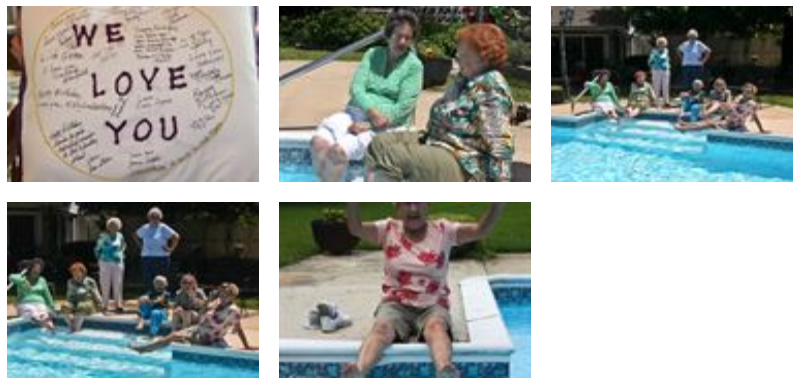
