



Roy Kenneth Spurgeon

April 2, 1924 - January 14, 2013

Roy K. Spurgeon, 88, of Grant died Monday, January 14. He had been in declining health for about a year. He was a member of Claysville Holiness Church.

He was the last of 10 children of the late Thomas B. and Jeanette Gamble Spurgeon. He was one of 6 brothers who served his country during WWII. His most recent occupations before retirement were propane gas truck driver and school bus driver. He enjoyed gardening and working with livestock. The most important thing in his life was his service to the Lord. He was well known for his love of the Word of God and his conversation which most often concerned the Scriptures. Many times he had expressed his desire to live as long as he could be a help to others, but when the time came that he was no longer able to do so, he would be ready to go.

He is survived by his wife, Kate Smith Spurgeon and 2 daughters, Carolyn Turnbow and LaVonne Castle (Leon). He also leaves 2 grandchildren, Kevin Castle (Christy) and Kari Click (Joshua): 5 great-grandchildren, Travis Castle, Mollie Castle, Ryan Click, Jordan Click and Canaan Click along with several nieces and nephews.
