“*Shirwell was my first cousin but he almost seemed like a big brother. There has never been anyone more outgoing and likable than Shirwell. You couldn't dislike him even if you wanted to.*

I remember a funny story that I will share. Shirwell and his brothers loved to fish and so did me and my brothers. One summer in the late 1970's I came down to Alabama on vacation and so did my older brother Anthony. I got permission to fish on Joe Frank Benson's old homeplace up on Grant Mountain. He had a great pond at the back and it had some big bass in it. Shirwell and Georgia were living in that house at the time. Me and Anthony pulled up by the house just as the sun was rising that morning. Just about the time we got our gear together and headed to the pond, Shirwell stepped out on the front porch stretching (he had just gotten out of bed). He saw us and said, "what are you boy's doing here?". We told him that we were going fishing and he said that he would join us but that he couldn't stay long because he had to go to work that morning (he may have been selling Insurance at the time .. but I don't remember for sure). Well, we got down to the pond and the bass were really biting because Shirwell had showed us this new bass lure called a "Weed Wing" and boy was it working! Finally he suggested that we all go back to the house and let Georgia fix us some breakfast and we did. The breakfast was mighty good and I still remember, to this day, how he teased Georgia that morning. He looked at me and said, "what kind of parents would name their daughter Georgia?". After we ate he once again said that he would fish with us a little while longer but that he had to get to work pretty soon. Shirwell never went to work that day! :)
