She was a member of the Girl Scouts of North Central Alabama, troop #548, from 2007-2017. The patches for the girl scouts were sewn by her as well. Ms. Parker was a proud member of the KDS DAR High School, Class of 1962.

Ms. Parker had been employed by Redstone Arsenal for 56 years. She started her career with NASA in 1964 and then transferred to Pensacola Navy Base in 1969. She then came back to Redstone Arsenal in 1971, where she worked for the Army and Missile Defense until she retired.

Ms. Parker shared a special bond with her grandchildren, who were the highlight of her life.
